

General Limits

Size and weight limits are as follows:

- Aircraft 18 ounces and under, including the weight of the battery
- Helicopters 450 size and smaller

Combat

Mass launch (1 heat) 2.4 technology encouraged, 72 MHz on a first come first serve basis.

12 oz. weight limit with battery. The winner will be inspected at the end of match. 800mil. battery pack maximum. All planes will be subject to weighing and impounding immediately before the match.

All pilots will be monitored to insure engagement. No running and hiding at the ceiling will be permitted. If the airplane touches the ground at any point during the match, this is grounds for immediate disqualification.

If the airplane survives a mid air and is "controllable", it will be allowed to continue. If it is deemed "unsafe", you will be asked to land immediately.

No leading edge cutting devices will be permitted for safety reasons.

Pylon Race

Airframe: Prop driven. No ducted fans.

Weight: 12oz. weight limit with battery.

Course: 2 pylon w/pilots standing off course.

Length: 6 laps

Depending on the number of participants there may be several classes of races, such as Cessna 210 class, Vapor class, and unlimited class.

Night Flight

Any lighted or glow in the dark aircraft may participate in Night Flight, the general weight and size limits apply.

Hovering and Limbo Contest

General weight limits apply. Pilots will fly the prescribed maneuvers, a winner will be determined for both events.
